Description

Sixteen (16)-hour course intended for Response Team Technical Advisors.

Course Objectives

Give participants the required knowledge and have them practice recognized response techniques to :

- Identify hazards ;
- Select appropriate personal protective equipment ;
- Evaluate a situation, and respond within an Incident Command System ;
- Select appropriate response techniques and procedures ;
- Understand the Technical Advisor's role on a spill/accident site.

Through briefings, workshops and drills, participants will learn how to :

- Know and understand the Canadian Chemical Producers' Association Emergency Plan ;
- Identify hazards and hazardous materials by consulting reference documents and manuals, or by using detection devices ;
- Understand and interpret hazardous goods chemical and physical data ;
- Select and use appropriate personal protective equipment and clothing ;
- Implement an Emergency Response plan ;
- Carry out tasks and functions assigned within the Incident Command System in place on an incident site ;
- Assess risks on an incident site.

This course is intended for :

- Members of Emergency Response Teams in the industry and public services ;
- Health, Safety & Environment Managers and Specialists.
